### //// 5. ENTRY FEES ////

### //// 6. THE COMPETITION ////

The format of the competition is as follows:

- *Qualifying Races – there will be five qualifying races with one member of each team in each of the five races. Each qualifying race will consist of 2 practice laps and 5 timed laps*
- *The 30 drivers posting the fastest individual lap time will go forward to the Quarter - Final rounds.*
- *The remaining 20 drivers will qualify for the Plate Competition*
- *Quarter -Finals – there will be 3 races consisting of 2 practice laps and 5 racing laps. The 20 drivers posting the fastest individual lap time will go forward to the Semi-Finals*
- *Plate Competition – there will be 2 races to compete for a place in the Plate Final. Each race will consist of 2 practice laps and 5 racing laps. The first 5 finishers in each race will go forward to the Plate Final*
- *Semi-Finals – there will be 2 races to compete for a place in the Championship Final. Each race will consist of 2 practice laps and 5 racing laps. The first 5 finishers in each race will go forward to the Championship Final*
- *Plate Final – 1 race consisting of 2 practice laps and 5 racing laps.*
- *Championship Final – there will be 1 race consisting of 2 practice laps and 5 racing laps*

There will therefore be a total of 14 races and every driver of every team will compete in a minimum of 2 races.

### //// 7. RESULTS ////

- *All go karts are fitted with a transponder relaying lap times to the computerised timing system at Phuket Racing Go Kart Co. Ltd.*
- *Results for the Qualifying races will be determined by selecting the 30 drivers with the fastest individual lap times*
- *Results for the Quarter and Semi Finals of both Championship and Plate events will be determined by finishing order in the races.*
- *Results for the Finals will be determined by finishing order in the races*
- *Team Results will be lowest aggregate of the fastest individual lap times of the four fastest drivers in each team..*
